



SINGAPORE UNIVERSITY GAMES (SUniG) RULES & REGULATIONS (Updated in July 2018)



1 TITLE

The name of the Games Series shall be known as the **Singapore University Games**, hereafter referred to as the SUniG.

2 OBJECTIVES

To foster goodwill and friendship through sports, among the students of the participating universities.

3 DATES

The SUniG shall be held annually and the dates shall be decided by the **Singapore Universities Sports Council (SUSC)** hereafter referred to as the Council.

4 ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Matriculated students starting term in the same year of the SUniG from the Universities pursuing degree or diploma courses (full-time, part-time, exchange, LOA) are eligible to participate.

4.2 The institutes participating in SUniG are:

4.3 The release of the final year result shall be used as the cut-off date to determine a student's eligibility to play for the institution concerned.

4.4 Approval is granted for SIT, SUTD and SUSS to field their students graduating/graduated in 2018 prior to the start of SUniG. This approval will be reviewed year by year.

5 ENTRIES

5.1 All team entries shall be confirmed to the respective convenors *4 weeks* before the commencement of each competition.

5.2 Any **team event** with less than 4 teams participating 2 years in a row shall not be convened. Likewise, any **individual event** with less than 4 entries from 3 universities shall not be convened.

6 COMPETITION RULES

6.1 Please refer to specific sports rules governing the respective sports. Any modification to rules has to be agreed by all convenors, and approved by the Council.

6.2 All sports would be played in the round robin format without “Final Match”. Respective game convenors may propose to host “Final Match” upon agreement from the other participating institutions.

8 **POSTPONEMENT**

No postponement shall be allowed unless decided upon by the convenor of the game in consultation with the game officials, referees or umpires.

9 **HAZE POLICY**

Please refer to Annex A for the SUniG Haze Policy.

10 **DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE**

A Disciplinary Committee shall be convened at the request of any convenor for serious offences committed during the proceedings of the game.

11 **PROTESTS**

All protests shall be submitted in writing through the staff official of the institution concerned **at the end of the match concerned** or otherwise specified by the Rules of each game.

12 **BOARD OF APPEAL**

The Council shall appoint the Board of Appeal comprising one representative from each institution.

13 **TEAM MANAGEMENT**

Each team shall be managed by a full-time or part-time staff from the participating institutions as long as they are endorsed by the institution's sports office.

14 **CONVENORS**

14.1 The convenorship for the sports will be decided annually, based on the total hosting cost and the university's percentage of participation in all the sports

14.2 Any new universities joining the SUniG shall be rostered to chair the Council at its fourth year of participation.

15 **MEDALS**

15.1 Medals shall be awarded to the top 3 placings of each team competition/event.

15.2 The medals contested at the Games can be found in Annex B.

16 **CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY**

16.1 The Challenge Trophy shall be awarded to the overall champion university of the Games.

16.2 The overall champion university of the Games will be awarded to the University with the highest number of Championship Points. If there is a tie in Championship Points, the University with the highest number of 2nd placings (followed by 3rd placings, if tie persists) in Championship Points computation will be awarded the Trophy.

16.3 The Championship Points contested at the Games could be found in Annex B.

17 **INDEMNITY**

The Council, convening institutions and/or its appointed officials shall not be held responsible for any injury or death to any player or official during, or as a result of his/her participation in the games.

18 **OFFICIAL RESULTS, PICTURES AND REPORTS**

18.1 Convenors shall send daily updates, pictures and results to SUSC Secretariat within 24 hours of the last day game.

18.2 Convenors shall send the official results in the official format to all institutions within one week of the completion of each competition.

19 **GENERAL RULES**

19.1 Any team which arrives after the grace period of fifteen minutes, fails to abide by the decision of the referee, or refuses to continue with the match shall be considered as having conceded a "walk-over".

19.2 If a team concedes a "walk-over", it is deemed to have withdrawn from the competition. All previous scores of the team shall be deleted.

19.3 With the approval of the SUSC, the convenor may amend any portion of the game rules as deemed necessary.

20 **MATTERS UNPROVIDED FOR**

All matters not provided for in these Rules shall be dealt with by the SUSC, whose decision is final.
