



# Selection Policy for Singapore University Archery Team Summer World University Games 2025 Rhine-Ruhr, Germany

## 1. Summary of Important Information

<b>Eligibility:</b>	1) Singapore Citizen (Singapore Passport Holder) 2) Age between 18 and 25 years old on 31 Dec 2025 (DOB between 1 Jan 2000 to 31 Dec 2007, both dates inclusive) 3) Active student in 2025 or former student with degree conferred in 2024

## 2. General Information

- 2.1. The FISU Summer World University Games 2025 (WUG 2025), will be held in the Rhine-Ruhr region, Germany from 16 to 27 July 2025.
- 2.2. The Singapore University Sports Council (SUSC) is planning to send the Archery Team to compete in WUG 2025, subject to athletes' qualification.
- 2.3. The travelling dates for the Archery Team will tentatively be from 19-27 July 2025 (competition dates are 22-26 July).
- 2.4. On behalf of SUSC, the Nanyang Technological University (NTU) will be managing this team.

2.5. Athletes who are interested may register at this link before 22/9/24 <https://forms.office.com/r/8h15JRxcqV>. Your results from any official distance trials or competitions organised by AAS or WA/WAA will be monitored and could be used for qualification consideration.

### 3. Eligibility

3.1. Only the following may participate as athletes in WUG 2025

- 3.1.1. Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute, the status of which is recognised by the appropriate national/regional academic authority of their country/region;
- 3.1.2. Former students of the institutions mentioned in 3.1.1 who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year preceding the event.

3.2. All athletes must satisfy the following conditions:

- 3.2.1. Be a national/citizen of the country/region they represent;
- 3.2.2. Be at least 18 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31 December of the year of the event (i.e., born between 1 January 2000 and 31 December 2007).

3.3. Athletes participating in FISU sport events must represent the same country/region as in their respective International Federation events. Changes of sport nationality/citizenship must follow respective IF rules.

3.4. Athletes of non-SUSC member IHLs e.g. Polytechnics and overseas Universities, must be athletes in the national squad endorsed by their respective National Sport Associations.

### 4. Events and Qualification Marks

4.1. The Archery Team will be taking part in the following events (*do note that there will be a limited number of entries that each participating country can send per event*):

5.1. Archers from SUSC member universities, you should be shooting on a fairly regular basis the following minimal scores by December 24 before registering for trial.

5.2. Archers who had hit the QM/PQM are encouraged to attend the official trial to try to better your scores.

**5.3. You will require your Sport Officer's support to attend the official trials by 23/12/24.**

## 6. Selection System

Archers are to meet the QM/PQM at least once in the period stated above.

- 6.1. The average of 2 best scores will be used to rank the archers. If there is a tie, the 3<sup>rd</sup> best score (if any) will be the tiebreaker.
- 6.2. If there are less than 3 archers made the QM/PQM in a category:
  - 6.2.1. AAS could consider recommending archers in current NATT/NYATT as part of national athletes' development support.
  - 6.2.2. SUSC member university could consider recommending next ranked archer/s who contributed greatly to the university programme (to facilitate possible participation in Team Event).
  - 6.2.3. Such recommendation is subjected to approval by SUSC, and funding support by their parent institution may differ.
- 6.3. SUSC will have the final decision.

## **7. Athletes' Obligations**

- 7.1. Selected athletes must fully comply with SUSC, AAS and WA rules, regulations and policies.
- 7.2. Selected athletes must fully comply with all anti-doping regulations. Athletes who require Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) have the duty to obtain one at least three months before the commencement of competition.
- 7.3. Selected athletes must maintain a level of fitness and performance consistent with the requirements of being a national representative.
- 7.4. Upon qualification, athletes must continue to show commitment towards preparing for WUG 2025, including all organised training sessions. Failure to do so may result in being dropped from the team.

## **8. Cost and Funding**

- 8.1. The participation cost per athlete is estimated to be between \$4,500 and \$5,000 and will be subjected to changes. The cost includes FISU registration fee, participation fee, travel expenses, insurance, attire, coaching, and others.
- 8.2. Selected athletes and/or the athletes' institution shall bear full cost of participating in WUG 2025, as well as the preparations leading up to it.
- 8.3. Athletes should check with their respective institutions with regards to subsidies, without which, the selected athlete is required to bear the full cost.
