



Selection Policy for Singapore University Athletics Team Summer World University Games 2025 Rhine-Ruhr, Germany

1. Summary of Important Information

2. General Information

- 2.1. The FISU Summer World University Games 2025 (WUG 2025), will be held in the Rhine-Ruhr region, Germany from 16 to 27 July 2025.
- 2.2. The Singapore University Sports Council (SUSC) is planning to send an Athletics Team to compete in WUG 2025, subject to athletes' qualification.
- 2.3. The travelling dates for the Athletics Team will tentatively be from 17 - 28 July 2025 (competition dates are 21-27 July).
- 2.4. On behalf of SUSC, the Nanyang Technological University will be managing this team.
- 2.5. Athletes who are interested in standing for selection must inform Ms Neo Wanxian/Wanxian.neo@ntu.edu.sg by registering via the link before 10 Jan 2025 <https://forms.office.com/r/NQmq2V3aDh>. Your results from any official trials or competitions organised by SAA will be monitored and could be used for qualification consideration.

3. Eligibility

3.1. Only the following may participate as athletes in WUG 2025:

- 3.1.1. Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute, the status of which is recognised by the appropriate national/regional academic authority of their country/region;
- 3.1.2. Former students of the institutions mentioned in 3.1.1 who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year preceding the event.

3.2. All athletes must satisfy the following conditions:

- 3.2.1. Be a national/citizen of the country/region they represent;
- 3.2.2. Be at least 18 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31 December of the year of the event (i.e., born between 1 January 2000 and 31 December 2007).

3.3. Athletes participating in FISU sport events must represent the same country/region as in their respective International Federation events. Changes of sport nationality/citizenship must follow respective IF rules.

4. Events

5. Selection of Athletes

5.1. Students of non-SUSC member IHLs e.g. Polytechnics and overseas Universities, must be carded athletes endorsed by their respective National Sport Associations.

5.2. 2 best competition results from sanctioned meets and results established under legal wind speed condition from 1 July 2024 – 28 Feb 2025.

*QM is derived from the better of Games Entry Standard, or

- i. respective events' qualifying results to the 2023 WUG Athletics Finals;
- ii. 12th placing results for Straight Finals events with less than 24 entries;
- iii. Round One/Qualifying 50% percentile.

*PQM is derived from the better of Games Entry Standard, or within 2% from the QM. Refer to excel breakdown with PQM consideration.

- 5.5. Relay team will be considered from the pool of athletes who meet QM/PQM for individual events.
- 5.6. Decathlon (Men) and Heptathlon (Women) will be considered if the athlete meet QM/PQM of the other individual events.
- 5.7. Appeal cases may be considered for 1st in tertiary and within 2% of entry standard or 1st in Singapore open meets.
- 5.8. For athletes who are overseas during selection period, overseas competition results may be submitted for consideration. The acceptance of the results is subject to Singapore Athletics' evaluation.
- 5.9. SUSC, with the recommendation of Singapore Athletics, will have the final decision.

6. Athletes' Obligations

- 6.1. Selected athletes must fully comply with SUSC, Singapore Athletics, and World Athletics rules, regulations and policies.
- 6.2. Selected athletes must fully comply with all anti-doping regulations. Athletes who require Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) have the duty to obtain one at least three months before the commencement of competition.
- 6.3. Selected athletes must maintain a level of fitness and performance consistent with the requirements of being a national representative.
- 6.4. Upon qualification, athletes must continue to show commitment towards preparing for WUG 2025, including all organised training sessions. Failure to do so may result in being dropped from the team.

7. Cost and Funding

- 7.1. The participation cost per athlete is estimated to be between \$4,700 and \$5,300 and will be subjected to changes. The cost includes FISU registration fee, participation fee, travel expenses, insurance, attire, coaching, and others.
- 7.2. Selected athletes and/or the athletes' institution shall bear full cost of participating in WUG 2025, as well as the preparations leading up to it.
- 7.3. Athletes should check with their respective institutions with regards to subsidies, without which, the selected athlete is required to bear the full cost.
